NESTLED IN THE HEART OF SPAIN'S BASQUE COUNTRY, many cyclists stateside have never heard of the Beistegui Hermanos brand. However, the company boasts more than 100 years of heritage, with the Beistegui brothers founding the company in 1908 as a firearm manufacturer. BH branched out into bicycles in 1923 and is now one of Europe's largest bike makers. If you've never heard of them, you haven't been living under a rock; BH only

entered the North American market four years ago. They came out swinging though, with their G5 ready to run with the big boys right from the get-go. The flagship G5 features oversized tubing throughout, making for an incredibly stiff platform that begs to be ridden in the feisty tradition of its Basque roots. And at 810 grams for a 54-centimeter frame with a top-notch parts selection, the bike obliges you to do just so. / [bhbikes-us.com](http://bhbikes-us.com)
